

## Clean Up Day

Clean up day this year will be May 8<sup>th</sup>

Only one pass per street.

Households are limited to no more than a pickup truck sized load.

Loose debris needs to be in a container.

No construction debris (roofing, siding porches and home renovation) will be picked up.

No recyclables will be collected for clean-up day.

No paint, tires, or animal waste will be picked up.

Please do not put out items until 48 hrs. Before Monday clean-up.

## Brush

Brush will be picked up April until October on or near the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month.

Contractors removing whole trees are responsible for the disposal of the tree.

Grass clippings will not be collected.

Please place brush in piles and not one continuous pile.

Keep brush under 10ft in length.

Do not mix brush with leaves.

Do not cover fire hydrants.

We will not be responsible to collect brush from lots that have been clear cut.

## Leaves

Leaves will be picked up in the spring until May clean-up day.

In the fall leaves will be picked up until the snow arrives.

Place unbagged leaves curbside for collection.

Do not mix with brush or garbage.

## ***Village of Black River Garbage & Recycling information***

**Household garbage** is collected every Monday (Tuesday in the event of a Village observed holiday)

**Only clear bags will be picked up after June 1<sup>st</sup> 2017. White and black bags will not be picked up.**

Garbage must be placed curbside by 8:00am and no earlier than 7:00pm the night before.

Any uncollected garbage must be removed from the curb within 24 hrs.

The following items cannot be collected with garbage:

Tires

Paint

Dog waste

Ashes

Construction debris

Grass clippings

Furniture

Electronic waste

Recyclables

Items over 50 lbs. (except for tipper cans)

The Village encourages the use of tipper cans for families that generate large amounts of garbage. These can be purchased at local home improvement stores

**Village ordinance prohibits the importation of garbage from outside the Village.**

**Recycling in the Village is the first and third Thursday of every month**

The Village is now collecting recyclables single stream. All recyclables can be placed in one container. Please do not use garbage bags for recyclables.

# ITEMS ACCEPTED CURBSIDE FOR RECYCLING

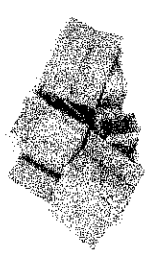
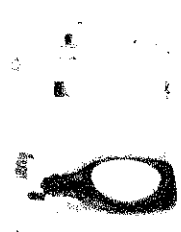
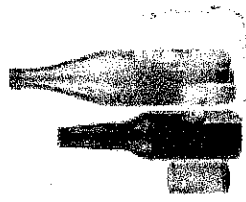


Recycling is Required by Law.

Hard Cover Books, Napkins, Paper Plates or Tissue Paper

### DO NOT INCLUDE:

Plastic Bags, Styrofoam Containers, Toys, Motor Oil Bottles, Prescription Bottles or Clothes Hangers

### DO NOT INCLUDE:

Propane Tanks, Metal-Cardboard Containers (Cocoa & Motor Oil), Clothes Hangers, Silverware, Small Appliances or Paint Cans

### DO NOT INCLUDE:

Broken Glass, Drinking Glasses, Ovenware or Ceramics, Dishes, Mirrors, Window Glass or Light Bulbs
