

Village of Black River Garbage Collection

Regular weekly garbage collection is every Monday (unless a holiday is observed then it will be picked up on Tuesday). Have garbage in clear or white bags placed at the street by 8:00am or no earlier than 7:00pm the evening before. Visit our website @ www.blackriverny.org

Village of Black River Recycling Program

The Village of Black River participates in a mandatory recycling program in conjunction with Jefferson County. The purpose of this program allows the reuse of materials, cut down on our landfill space, and helps defer the cost the village pays for the disposal of solid waste. Recyclables are collected in the Village the first and third Thursday every month. Please put recyclables at the curb by 8:00am Thursday or no sooner than 7:00pm the evening before. Please separate large amounts (over one bin) by category and only clean recyclables will be collected. Garbage cans or garbage bags of mixed recyclables will not be collected. CARDBOARD

Corrugated cardboard and brown paper bags only.

Do not include food boxes, milk cartons, or packing foam (put these in your garbage).

NEWSPAPER

Include clean newspaper contained so it will not blow in your neighbor's yard.

MAGAZINES AND MIXED PAPER

Include magazines and junk mail and keep separate from newspaper.

Do not include books, paper towels, or paper plates

PLASTIC

Include only plastic bottles and jugs with caps removed. Also plastic yogurt and butter containers are now accepted.

Do not include plastic bags or toys.

TIN AND ALUMINUM

Metal food and beverage cans and metal caps and lids

Do not include aerosol cans, paint cans, hangers, or scrap metal.

GLASS

Glass bottles and jars only with caps removed. Broken glass should be placed in the garbage.
